Component	What to Inspect	Notes
Tires	Check for proper inflation, tread depth, and any visible damage like cracks or punctures.	
Axles	Look for any signs of wear, leaks, or damage around the axle area.	
Hitch & Coupler	Inspect the hitch for rust, wear, and secure connections. Confirm coupler is locked to the hitch.	
Jack	Ensure the jack operates smoothly and can support the trailer's weight when detached from the vehicle.	
Lights	Test brake lights, turn signals, and running lights for full functionality.	
Brakes	If equipped, verify brakes work and are properly connected to the towing vehicle.	
Safety Chains	Ensure chains are in good condition and connected securely to the tow vehicle.	
Interior	Look inside for any damage, clean space, and secure tie-downs for cargo.	
Doors & Latches	Check doors for functionality and secure latches for safe travel.	
Roof & Exterior	Examine for any dents, holes, or leaks that could allow water or air to enter.	
Electrical Wiring	Look for exposed or frayed wires that could cause issues while driving.	
Reflectors	Ensure all reflectors are intact and clean for visibility.
